BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 88-28, BEING
A BY-LAW TO IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON THE
WATERING OF LAWNS AND GARDENS

WHEREAS section 2 (c) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that Municipalities are given powers to foster the municipality's current and future economic, social and environmental well-being;

AND WHEREAS section 11 (2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that lower-tier municipalities within the Regional Municipality of Waterloo are assigned the non-exclusive sphere of jurisdiction for Public Utilities – Water Distribution;

AND WHEREAS By-Law Number 03-025 for the Regional Municipality of Waterloo, a By-Law Respecting the Outdoor Use of Water, is enforced only upon The Commissioner's declaration of a Stage 2 water supply emergency;

AND WHEREAS the Corporation of the Township of Wilmot wishes to allow for the watering of new lawn and gardens outside of Stage 2 water supply emergencies.

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

THAT notwithstanding By-Law No. 88-28, irrigation is permitted for the following:


- (a) newly planted sod or grass seed forming part of a lawn for twenty-four hours after planting or seeding and for six consecutive calendar days thereafter between the hours of 7:00 am and 10:00 am and between the hours of 7:00 pm and 11:00 pm.
- (b) lawns treated with any pesticide, herbicide or fertilizer that require irrigation while being treated and during the 24 hours following the treatment.


