BY-LAW NO. 88-28

BY-LAW TO IMPOSE RESTRICTIONS ON THE
WATERING OF LAWNS AND GARDENS.

WHEREAS Section 208(31) of The Municipal Act,
R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 302, as amended, permits
municipalities to pass by-laws for preserving waters within
the Township.


THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE
CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall water or permit to be watered any lawn
and garden within the municipally serviced areas of
the Township of Wilmot except in accordance with the
following:
 - (a) Persons will be permitted to water lawns and
gardens of municipally even numbered properties
between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
and between the hours of 7:00 p.m. and
11:00 p.m. on even numbered days of the
month.
 - (b) Persons will be permitted to water lawns and
gardens of municipally odd numbered
properties between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and
10:00 a.m. and between the hours of 7:00
p.m. and 11:00 p.m. on odd numbered days
of the month.

2. Should the provisions of any other By-law, Resolution or action of Council be inconsistent with this By-law, then this By-law shall prevail.

3. Every person who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law shall, upon conviction thereof, forfeit and pay a penalty not exceeding (exclusive of costs) the sum of Two Thousand (\$2,000.00) Dollars for each such offence and every such penalty shall be recoverable under The Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1980, Chapter 400, as amended.
