CHANGE NOTICE

RE: Wilmot Dog Licensing (Dog Tags)

What is changing?

Beginning in 2012 the Township will begin to issue "Multi-Year" dog tags. These multi-year tags will be good for 2012 through 2016 (5 years). By using these multi-year tags, the Township of Wilmot will only have to mail out "new" tags every 5 years, and you won't be required to constantly update the dog tag being worn by your dog.

After you receive your invoice and dog tag for 2012, you will only receive an annual renewal invoice for 2013 through 2016 with no need to change the tag your dog is wearing.

What is staying the same?

The Township of Wilmot will still mail your dog tag for 2012 along with your invoice. Following this, from 2013 through 2016 you will continue to receive an annual renewal invoice (which must be paid in order to have your dog tag remain active).

What is the reason for this change?

By implementing a "multi-year" dog tag system, the Township will be able to generate cost savings. With costs to the Township constantly increasing, the savings generated by this change will ensure that the Township will not have to raise the price of a dog tag in the near future.

What if I lose my dog tag?

If your dog tag is lost at any point during the 5 year period, you will be able to get a replacement tag from the Township at a cost of \$3.00. Simply advise the Township that you have lost your tag, proving your name and address along with the replacement fee, and the Township will send your replacement tag in the mail.
