Construction Notice **Baden Sanitary Trunk Sewer Installation**

As part of the Baden Trunk Sanitary project, the Township of Wilmot is proceeding with the construction through Gingerich Road as illustrated below. The Contractor for this work is Steed & Evans Ltd. of St. Jacobs, Ontario. Construction is anticipated to start week of January 13th, 2025 with completion estimated mid-march 2025 weather dependant.



Traffic Concerns - Access to Businesses, Residences and Side Streets

The Contractor will make all attempts to minimize inconveniences from construction activities including dust and construction activities are scheduled from 7am to 7pm pursuant to the Township Noise-By-Law. Should activities be required outside of this timeframe, notice will be provided.

Access to businesses and residences along Gingerich Road will be maintained through a single traffic lane. Additional, disruptions are anticipated during construction activities within the intersection of Foundry Street and Gingerich Road. Advanced notice will be provided to businesses and residences when construction activities are anticipated to affect access or municipal services.

Motorists should follow the construction signage when driving or walking through the construction zone and follow the direction provided traffic control persons for your safety and for the safety of the workers.

Signage will be erected to direct pedestrians.

Canada Post Mail Delivery (for properties within the active construction limits only)

Properties that receive door service mail delivery should not be affected while construction is taking place. If you do experience a disruption in your mail delivery, please contact Canada Post at 1-866-607-6301 or go to their website www.canadapost.ca or contact the Township's representative.

Restoration and Landscaping

The work on this project includes the reinstatement of landscaping to preconstruction conditions or better. Landscaping or planting materials within right-of-way should be removed prior to construction activities taking place. If in doubt, please contact the Inspector or Contractor to determine if plantings will be disturbed during construction.

Working Hours

Normal working hours are Monday to Friday from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 pm. Occasional weekend work may occur from time to time.
