



COVID-19 INSPECTION PROTOCOL – May 21, 2020

In order to ensure the health and safety of residents, contractors and Municipal staff, effective immediately and until further notice, Township of Wilmot will conduct building, plumbing and septic inspections under the following protocols:

1. Inspections should be requested with advanced notice, at minimum 24hrs in advance. Please consider the urgency of the inspection and whether it can be postponed without significant impact to the project.
2. To ensure the protection of contractors, residents and staff we will require that proper physical distancing be maintained onsite. We ask that residents and contractors leave the area to be inspected during the inspection to ensure no violations of physical distancing occur.
3. If a violation of distancing occurs the inspector will verbally warn the contractor or resident. A second violation will result in the inspection being failed and the inspector leaving the site. The inspection will then need to be rebooked with proper assurances in place to ensure physical distancing. Is maintained.
4. An inspection will be refused if a person has previously been on site that would not clear the COVID-19 screening questionnaire. The questions are as follows:
 1. Have you or any sub-contractor on site travelled to/from outside of Canada in the last 14 days?
 2. Have you or any sub-contractor on site had close contact with a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?
 3. Have you or any sub-contractor on site been in close contact with someone who has been to/from an impacted area in the 14 days?
 4. Have you or any sub-contractor on site had any fever, cough or difficulty breathing?
5. Inspection slips will be emailed to the contact provided on the building permit application form, or a Green Inspection sticker will be left on site. Inspection deficiencies will not be discussed in person but can be discussed by phone or email.
