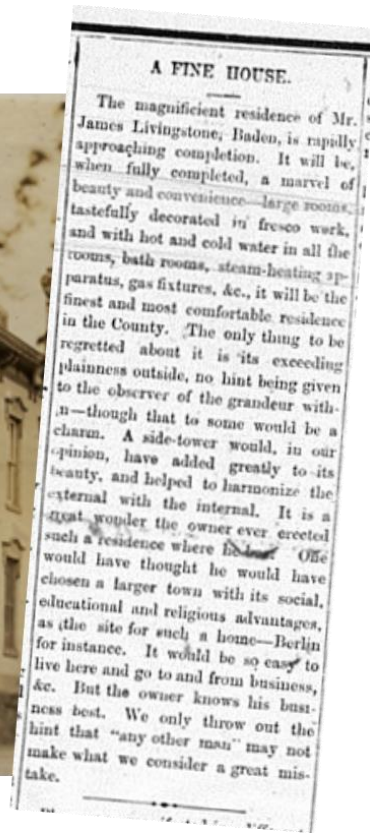


August 10- Castle Kilbride A Fine House
