Creating your display:

If you would like to share your original documents with your display, putting them inside a plastic sleeve and into binders is a suggestion and will be easy for the public to view without damaging your originals.
- Include items such as organization, family/business, genealogy or property history, photographs, business documents, property deeds, artifacts, renovations, and of course your stories. Be as creative as you wish with your display!
- Table space and two chairs will be provided for you. You may want to bring a table covering.
- One cardboard tabletop display board (3' x 4') is available *free of charge* for you to use to enhance your display (please contact Heritage Wilmot).
- Set-up takes place the morning of the event on Saturday February 23rd from 8:30 a.m. to 9:30 a.m. at the New Dundee Community Centre (<u>Note</u>: the event opens at 10:00 a.m. to the public)

- You, your organization, family or friends are encouraged to be with your display during the day. Your interaction with other community members contributes to the experience of the day.

- Parking is available on-site. Building is wheelchair accessible
