MUNICIPAL ELECTION SIGNS FACT SHEET

Municipal Election signs are governed by the Region of Waterloo By-law 10-030, a copy of the by-law and its amendments can be found at www.regionofwaterloo.ca, and the Township of Wilmot By-law 2002-68 (enclosed). Please note that the Region of Waterloo has recently amended their Sign By-law prohibiting Election Signs along Regional Roads.

Please review these reminders before you place your campaign signs on any property – for more specific information, please refer to the appropriate sign bylaw – the FACT SHEET is just a guide:

ELECTION SIGNS GENERAL:

- 1. Election signs cannot be placed on **any township property or road allowance** within The Township.
- Election signs can be placed on private property once the candidate has filed. Public property (road allowances) along Regional roads can be only 45 days prior to the election as per the Regional by-law.
- 3. Elections signs cannot be placed on **private property without the owner's consent.**
- 4. Election signs cannot be placed upon any **tree**, **post**, **pole or fence** on municipal property or any property under the jurisdiction of the municipality.
- 5. Election signs cannot be placed in such a manner as to obstruct a driver's/pedestrian's view of roadways or driveways or in such a manner as to interfere with the visibility or effectiveness of any traffic sign or traffic signal or traffic device.
- 6. Election signs cannot be placed on **property used as a voting location**.
- 7. Candidates or their duly appointed scrutineers **visiting a polling place should not display any election signs**, and will be asked to remove any button or sign on their person or vehicle.
- **8.** Election signs may not be **illuminated**.
- 9. Election signs **must be removed within 72 hours** after Voting Day (signs must be removed on or before October 17, 2022)

- 10. Signs are not to interfere with street lamps, power or telephone wires and poles, fire hydrants, fire escapes, fire exits or reservoir.
- 11. Signs that are posted in the controlled area of **Highway 7 & 8** must have the approval of the Ministry of Transportation.
- 12. Signs erected contrary to the Sign By-laws **may be removed without notice** and held for 30 days. If not picked up, they will be disposed of without notice or compensation to the owner.
- 13. Elections signs **cannot be placed on Regional road allowances** in accordance with the Regional Sign By-law amendment 21-064.
- **14**. The signs cannot be larger than **0.84 meters**.
