

Charting a Pathway Forward for the Township of Wilmot's Prime Ministers Path Through an Inclusive Public Engagement Process

<u>First Peoples Group</u>, a well-connected, senior and professional team of consultants with extensive networks of contacts from coast-to-coast-to-coast has been contracted to design and implement a public engagement process for the Township of Wilmot. Through a four-step process, residents of Wilmot will be engaged, in an inclusive manner, with the objective of developing community-led solutions and recommendations for a pathway forward for the Prime Ministers Path. The public engagement will be publicly launched in April, 2021 and will formally conclude when a report with recommendations, developed by residents of Wilmot through this process, is presented to Council on June 30, 2021.



Step 1 – Community Outreach & Launch Event

- This initial step will launch and introduce the public engagement process to the residents of Wilmot.
- A virtual launch event will be held that will serve as a primer for the public engagement process.

Step 2 – Community Conversation Sessions

- One-on-one conversations with community members with the goal of refining the engagement process.
- An opportunity to introduce First Peoples Group to the Township of Wilmot and validate the engagement plan.

Step 3 – Gathering Community Input

Input from residents of Wilmot will be gathered through a public questionnaire and a series of public focus groups.

Step 4 - Community Dialogue Session

A public open house with the purpose to verify and expand on engagement findings including draft recommendations that will be presented to Council.
