Re: Proposed Parking Prohibitions on Stiefelmeyer Crescent

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Dear Sir/Madam:

In a continued effort to enhance safety within the Township road network, Township staff are proposing the implementation of parking restrictions along the horizontal curve on Stiefelmeyer Crescent. These restrictions would prohibit parking on one side of the road. In this case the odd number side (North side) adjacent house #11 of the roadway leading up to and through the horizontal curve of the roadway would have "no parking" signs installed. These implementations aim to both widen the travel lanes available to vehicles as well as improve sightlines around these curves for the purpose of improving road safety.

The proposed restrictions will make traversing the curve much more comfortable and safe while providing extra pavement width for school buses, Township and Region service vehicles as well as emergency service vehicles to comfortably pass other passenger vehicles while travelling these tighter portions of the roadway.

In order to accommodate the proposed improvements, the removal of Three (3) legal on-street parking spaces on Stiefelmeyer Crescent would be required. Please refer to Figure 1 on the next page which shows the proposed parking restrictions.

Parking will be restricted between the 2 White symbols shown in the above photo.

Prior to making a final recommendation to Township Council, Township staff would appreciate your feedback on this enhanced road safety proposal and the on-street parking removal.
