

Province-wide shutdown impacts Township of Wilmot facilities, programs and services

The Province of Ontario announced a provincewide shutdown that will take effect Saturday, April 3, 2021, at 12:01am.

For Wilmot residents, this means:

- No indoor gatherings will be permitted with people outside of your household. If you live alone, or are a single parent, you may gather with one other household.
- Outdoor gatherings will be limited to 5 people with physical distancing.

Parks, Facilities & Recreation Services

- Wilmot Recreation Complex, including pools, walking track and arenas and Township owned community centres, will be closed until further notice and all programs and rentals cancelled.
- All Township parks, playgrounds, trails, the off-leash dog park, and other park amenities remain open. These are not sanitized by the Township. The dog park has a maximum capacity of 10 people, please continue to practice Physical Distancing when enjoying parks and recreations amenities.
- Cemeteries sales and services are available by appointment only and burials are permitted with physical distancing measures and 50 people maximum.
