DOG TAGS— Dog licences in the Township of Wilmot are issued as multi-year tags that are valid for five years (2017 through 2021). Annual renewal invoices have been mailed out and are due on March 31st. Dog owners are urged to ensure that their dog is wearing the tag. Township of Wilmot By-law No. 2008-01 requires that all dog owners purchase valid dog licences regardless of whether the dog has been microchipped. If you have not purchased a dog tag, tags can be purchased at the Township Office in Baden or online at www.wilmot.ca.

On or Before March 31, 2018 \$20.00

On & After April 1, 2018 \$30.00

CANINE CONTROL— Any resident who has lost their dog should contact the Township Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer at 519-634-8444 or the Kitchener-Waterloo Humane Society at 519-745-5615. Any dog found running at large will be taken to the KW Humane Society Facility.

WORKING SMOKE ALARMS—It's the Law and saves lives! Regulations under the Ontario Fire Code state that at least one working smoke alarm is required on every level of all homes, including levels that don't contain a sleeping area. Fire fatalities continue to plague our Province, be part of the solution, not the problem.

CARBON MONOXIDE ALARMS— Carbon monoxide alarms are required near all sleeping areas in residential homes and in the service rooms, and adjacent sleeping areas in multi-residential units.
