

TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT

BY-LAW NO. 93-66

**BY-LW TO PROHIBIT THE THROWING
PLACING OR DEPOSITING OF REFUSE OR DEBRIS
ON PRIVATE PROPERTY OR ON PROPERTY OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OR LOCAL BOARD THEREOF**

WHEREAS Section 210, Sub-Section 82 of the Municipal Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter M.45 provides that a municipality may pass a by-law to prohibit the throwing, placing or depositing of refuse or debris on private property or on property of the municipality or local board thereof:

THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WILMOT ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall throw, place or deposit refuse or debris on any private property within the Township of Wilmot or on any property belonging to the Township of Wilmot or any local board of the said Township without authority from the owner or occupant of such property.
2. That By-law No. 93-21 is hereby repealed and rescinded.
3. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law:
 - (i) is guilty of an offence, and
 - (ii) upon conviction thereof is liable to a fine or penalty of not more than \$5,000.00 as prescribed in the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.33.
