

Decision Number: MDE-2026-04

Date: February 10, 2026

Purpose: Notice to shorten the 10-day period for the Mayor to veto an amendment passed by Council to the Mayor's proposed budget

WHEREAS section 284.16 of Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 provides that the powers and duties of a municipality with respect to proposing and adopting a budget are assigned to the head of council of the municipality;

AND WHEREAS section 7(7) of Ontario Regulation 530/22 provides that the head of council may in a year shorten the 10-day veto period referred to in subsection (6) for the year by providing to each member of council and to the Clerk a written document specifying a shorter period;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Natasha Salonen, Mayor of the Township of Wilmot, hereby declare that:

1. The Mayor will not exercise the power to veto under subsection 284.16(4) of Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25.
2. This Decision provides written notice under subsection 284.16(4) of Part VI.1 of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 and subsection 7(7) of O. Reg. 530/22 to shorten the 10-day period to veto an amendment passed by Township Council to the Mayor's proposed budget, to 1 day after the expiry of the time period for council to pass a resolution under subsection 7(3) of O. Reg. 530/22.
